We've moved! Our municipal office has temporarily relocated to 28 Municipal Lane, Sundridge, in the lower level of the Strong Township building. Thank you for your patience during the transition.

If you have *accessibility requirements* we ask that you please contact the office by phone or email in order to make an appointment to speak to staff or to make property tax payments.

2019 Trailer Licenses are now due: The annual fee of \$550 is payable by cheque, cash, debit or credit.

2019 Dog Licenses are now due: Please visit the municipal office to purchase dog tags. All dogs are required to be licensed annually in the Township of Joly per By-law #2014-15.

Fire permits are required from April 1st to October 31st each year. Please monitor our

website for fire ratings and important fire ban information.

Let us know what you think! Comment Forms are welcome and encouraged. We have provided a blank comment form for your convenience as a rate-payer in Joly Township. Please drop off, mail, fax or email a completed comment form using the contact information noted above.

Fee Changes – some of our fees have changed recently including Trailer Licenses and Driveway Permit Applications. Please visit the By-Laws page of our website and select By-Law # 2018-19 for more information.

Landfill cards can be purchased at the Strong Township Municipal office located at 28 Municipal Lane, Sundridge.

Fire Safety & Prevention – Do you have a fire safety plan for your home, cottage, trailer or work place? It is an important tool in fire safety. When everyone knows what to do in the event of a fire, they will be calm and able to move to a safe place quickly. Check your smoke alarms and carbon monoxide alarms monthly. It is recommended to change the batteries with each daylight savings time change in the spring and fall. Smoke alarms should be replaced every 10 years.

Joly Township maintains service agreements with both the Sundridge Strong Fire Department and the South River Machar Fire Department to ensure that both departments are prepared to respond to service calls for Joly residents as required. Watch for changes to the Fire Rating signs as you enter Joly Township from Sundridge and South River.
