We've moved! Our municipal office has temporarily relocated to 28 Municipal Lane, Sundridge, in the lower level of the Strong Township building. Thank you for your patience during the transition.

If you have **accessibility requirements** we ask that you please contact the office by phone or email in order to make an appointment to speak to staff or to make property tax payments.

2019 Trailer Licenses are now due: The annual fee of \$550 is payable by cheque, cash, debit or credit.

2019 Dog Licenses are now due: Please visit the municipal office to purchase dog tags. All dogs are required to be licensed annually in the Township of Joly per By-law #2014-15.

Fire permits are required from April 1st to October 31st each year. Please monitor our

Fire Safety & Prevention – Do you have a fire safety plan for your home, cottage, trailer or work place? It is an important tool in fire safety. When everyone knows what to do in the event of a fire, they will be calm and able to move to a safe place quickly. Check your smoke alarms and carbon monoxide alarms monthly. It is recommended to change the batteries with each daylight savings time change in the spring and fall. Smoke alarms should be replaced every 10 years.

Joly Township maintains service agreements with both the Sundridge Strong Fire Department and the South River Machar Fire Department to ensure that both departments are prepared to respond to service calls for Joly residents as required. Watch for changes to the Fire Rating signs as you enter Joly Township from Sundridge and South River.

LOW	<p>NO DAYTIME BURNING ALLOWED</p> <p>Open Air Burning and Incinerators, including burn barrels with 3/8" mesh as lid allowed starting at 6pm and completely out by 10am.</p> <p>Only environmentally friendly products may be burned.</p> <p>Camp fires are allowed for cooking and warmth at any time.</p>
MODERATE	<p>NO DAYTIME BURNING ALLOWED</p> <p>Open Air Burning and Incinerators, including burn barrels with 3/8" mesh as lid allowed starting at 6pm and completely out by 10am.</p> <p>Only environmentally friendly products may be burned.</p> <p>Camp fires are allowed for cooking and warmth at any time.</p>
HIGH	<p>NO DAYTIME BURNING ALLOWED</p> <p>NO OPEN BURNING – NO FIREWORKS</p> <p>Only enclosed camp fires for cooking and warmth.</p> <p>Enclosed fire, surrounded by brick/stones or in metal burn container/ring no bigger than 2 feet/24 inches.</p>
EXTREME	<p>COMPLETE FIRE BAN</p> <p>NO BURNING ALLOWED at any time.</p> <p>NO FIREWORKS</p>
